A LETTER FROM OUR PRESIDENT



Since May of 2019, the Spencer County Educational Foundation has truly made a difference for the students and teachers in Spencer County Schools. And for that, we have YOU to thank, our donors and supporters, who have made this possible.

In just 4 years SCEF has raised \$125,000. Over \$70,000 has been awarded to 51 teachers in the district for grants they have applied for to impact students in their classrooms. Teachers have used the funds for initiatives from classroom books to a set of guitars for a music class, pasta making equipment to flexible seating and graphing calculators to electric balances for science labs. Almost \$48,000 has helped to increase the number of computers and iPad in the classrooms across the district. SCEF is also proud to be a large part of funding and growing the JROTC program at Spencer County High School.

In February SCEF hosted “Denim and Pearls”, our first annual event. Nearly 400 people attended enjoying an evening of live local music, great food and a fun opportunity to attend a local event at the perfect venue, The View at Plum Creek.

Our goal for the 2023-2024 school year is \$75,000. SCEF is grateful for any donation no matter the amount. We will continue the commitment to elevate the experience for teachers and students in our schools to impact the Spencer County community for years to come.
